In 2014, the Community Foundation awarded a total \$18,230 to help local organizations meet community needs. The following grants were awarded in 2014, as \$1:\$1 matching grants.

ACTS	\$2,5 00	To support ACTS in the transition from propane fuel to natural gas.
BACN	\$2,205	To provide utility assistance for families.
Goodwill Industries of NWMI	\$2,500	To support the street outreach program.
Good Samaritan Family Services	\$2,5 00	To help with the purchase of a new roof on the Good Samaritan Resale Shop and the adjoining valley.
GT Dyslexia Association	\$1,500	To provide financial assistance to low-income families who cannot afford the cost of tuition so that their children can receive uninterrupted tutorial services.
KAIR	\$2,5 00	To help cover the initial fee of bringing their audit records up to date and completing an audit of the last fiscal year.
NMCAA	\$1,000	To support food assistance for the Northwest Food Coalition.
ROCK of Kingsley	\$1,025	To support afterschool programming.
Traverse Health Clinic	\$2500	To purchase medical equipment to furnish a new exam room. With an increase in patients and the recent hiring of another physician they must reconfigure their current space to accommodate another exam room.
