Grand Traverse Regional Arts Campus	\$1,700	Support six recycled plastic park benches to be placed along the ¹ / ₂ mile exercise trail at the Arts Campus for use by Campus visitors and tenants.	
Grass River Natural Area, Inc.	\$2, 000	Support "Field Guide" to the natural history of Grass River and the Northwest Lower Michigan region.	
Interlochen Public Library	\$1,475	Funds for their New Library and Community Room capital campaign.	
Junior Achievement of Northwest MI	\$2,457	Support for wages for 13 at-risk Traverse City West Middle School students for a six week JA Economics for Success program that will teach students how to empower their futures and stay in school.

PEACE Ranch	\$2,5 00	Salary support for their new Program Director who will begin in September 2016.
